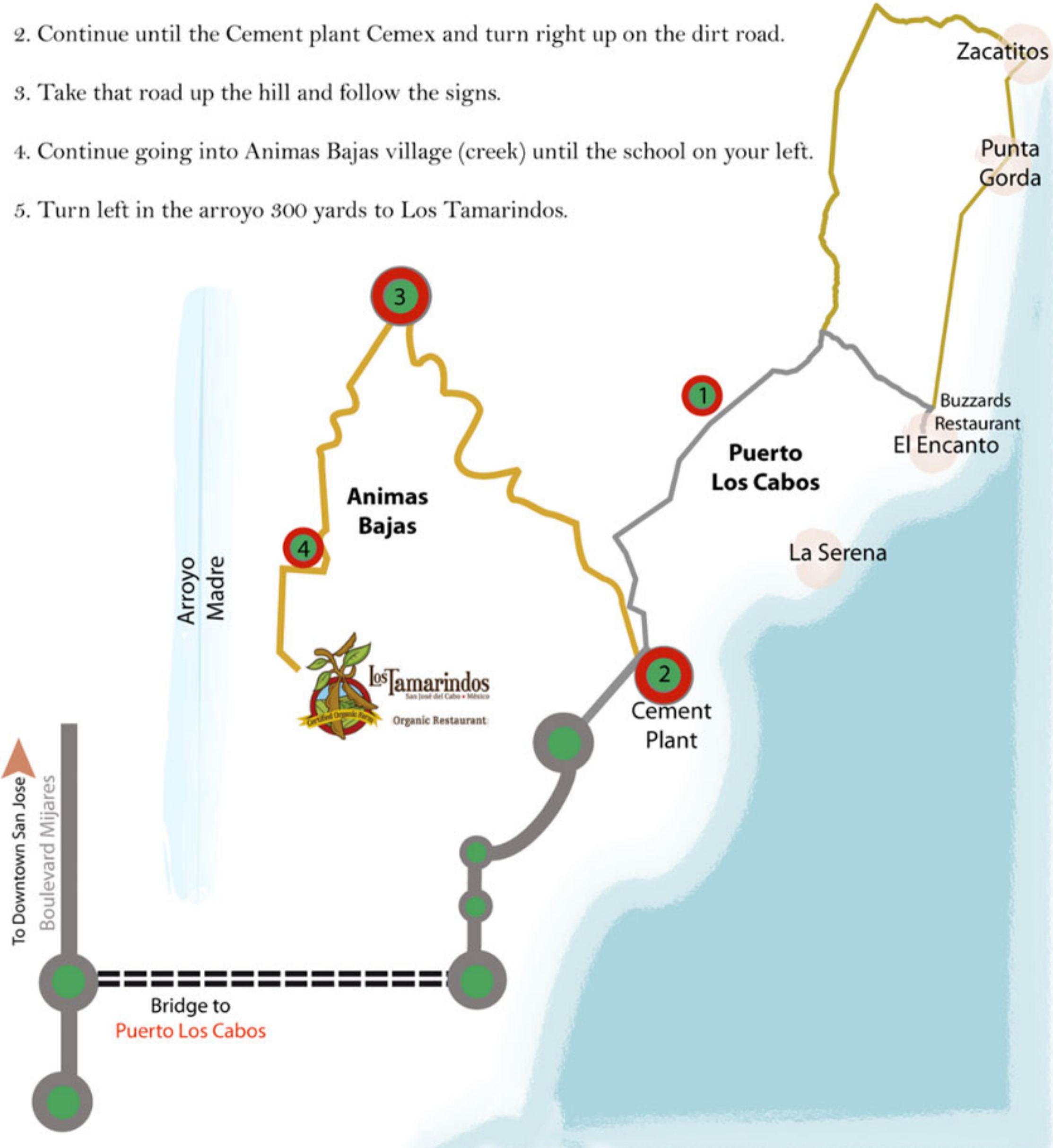


DIRECTIONS TO HUERTA LOS TAMARINDOS

1. Coming from Zacatitos, take the route to Puerto Los Cabos.
2. Continue until the Cement plant Cemex and turn right up on the dirt road.
3. Take that road up the hill and follow the signs.
4. Continue going into Animas Bajas village (creek) until the school on your left.
5. Turn left in the arroyo 300 yards to Los Tamarindos.



DIRECTIONS TO HUERTA LOS TAMARINDOS

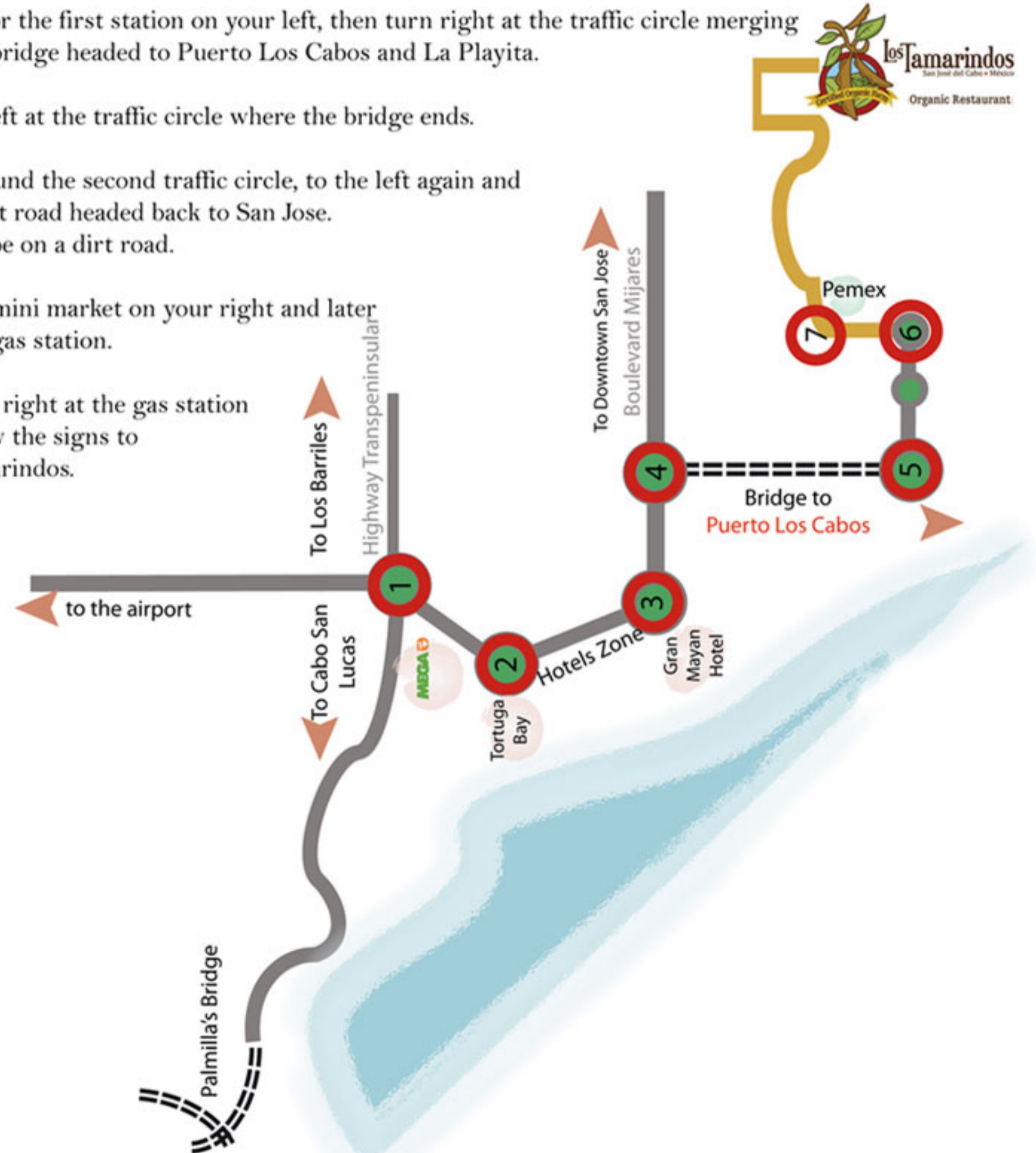
1. Coming from Cabo San Lucas, take a right at the stop sign at the Mega Supermarket.
2. Continue to Tortuga Bay (a beach front condo development), then bear left toward the hotel zone paralleling the beach.
3. Just past the Grand Mayan Hotel, turn left on Mijares Boulevard toward downtown San Jose del Cabo.

4. Look for the first station on your left, then turn right at the traffic circle merging onto the bridge headed to Puerto Los Cabos and La Playita.
5. Turn left at the traffic circle where the bridge ends.

6. Go around the second traffic circle, to the left again and onto a dirt road headed back to San Jose. You will be on a dirt road.

7. Pass a mini market on your right and later a Pemex gas station.

8. Make a right at the gas station and follow the signs to Los Tamarindos.



DIRECTIONS TO HUERTA LOS TAMARINDOS

1. Coming from Cabo San Lucas, take a right at the stop sign at the Mega Supermarket.
2. Continue to Tortuga Bay (a beach front condo development), then bear left toward the hotel zone paralleling the beach.

4. Look for the first station on your left, then turn right at the traffic.

5. Don't go by the bridge, just take your right and then pass under the bridge to your left.

6. Continue straight until Hotel El Encanto. You will see an enter of dirt road with signs to Mercado Organico and Jockey Club. Turn right inmediately, and follow the way.

7. Pass the Jockey Club and Mercado Organico (just open on Saturdays)

8. Continue always driving in your left and follow the signs to Los Tamarindos.
